DISTRICT POLICY REGARDING NEW WATER SERVICE INSTALLATIONS:

- A Kentucky State Plumbing Permit is required before a water meter can be installed. <u>This is in addition to your septic permit.</u> All service lines must be inspected by the State Plumbing Inspector. You can contact the plumbing inspector at the Lyon County Health Department on Thursdays between 8:00 and 9:30 a.m. Please contact Kyle Belmer 270-505-2166
- 2. It is the homeowners responsibility to install and also to maintain a pressure regulator, if one is desired.
- 3. Service lines shall be ³/₄ inch or larger installed at a minimum depth of 30 inches. Service lines shall be 160 PSI or greater.
- 4. The customer shall also install an approved expansion tank as required by the Kentucky State Division of Plumbing.
- 5. If a frost-free hydrant is installed, a Watts No. 7 backflow preventer must be installed.
- 6. No other source of water is to be connected to the District lines. Water service will be denied if a cross connection is found to exist.

DO NOT PLANT TRESS, FLOWERS OR SHRUBS AROUND THE METER!

THIS AREA MUST BE KEPT CLEAR FROM TALL GRASS AND WEEDS. ACCESS TO THE METER MUST BE AVAILABLE AT ALL TIMES.
